# **SECTION 10 - RECREATIONAL ZONE (RE) REGULATIONS**

# 10.1 GENERAL USE REGULATIONS

No person shall within the RE zone use any lot or erect, alter or use any building or structure except in accordance with the following regulations:

### 10.1.1 Permitted Uses

- a) private and public parks;
- b) private and public recreational uses, including golf courses and curling rinks;
- d) accessory uses to the foregoing uses in accordance with subsection 5.19 of this by-law, including a clubhouse, pro shop, snack bars and refreshment areas and other facilities associated with a golf course.

## 10.3 EXCEPTIONS

### 10.3.1 <u>DEFINED AREA RE-1</u> as shown on Schedule "A" to this by-law. (Lakewood's Tree Nursery)

- i) a commercial nursery and golf course maintenance facilities only;
- ii) accessory uses to the above permitted uses.

### b) Permitted Buildings and Other Structures

Buildings and structures for the permitted uses.

### c) Zone Provisions

All lot and building requirements for the permitted uses shall be in accordance with subsections 10.1.3 and 10.2 of this by-law.
