Engagement Design Direction

- · Create a quality streetscape and 24/7 all season community destination that encourages a small town/village feel, respects the heritage character and assets, and is pedestrian
- · Design to be sustainable with proper infrastructure choices and maintenance practices.
- · Animate the public realm by designing for all seasons and creating opportunities that attract people to the area.
- · Design for "quality downtown traffic" instead of "commuter traffic".

- · Bury the overhead wires.
- · Design to create a safe and comfortable pedestrian environment (24/7).
- · Establish a clear identity for Tecumseh Road, a unique balance between traditional and contemporary.
- · Design the street to accommodate different modes of transportation that explores opportunities for improving the pedestrian experience, transit and bicycle infrastructure.
- · Consider a role for the BIA in implementing/managing the






Legion Alley Access+ Lanoue Street






- Reviewed the Legion Alley lane access in detail


