As the Town of Tecumseh (Town) proceeds with finalizing the detailed design and construction of the Riverside Drive Multi-Use Trail, we are committed to continued communication with landowners and residents. The detailed design of the trail is nearing completion and is set to be tendered shortly for summer construction.

You are receiving this letter as landscaping or decorative features adjacent to your property, within the Town's right-of-way, have been identified for relocation or removal due to its impact or potential impact with construction. Two notices requesting an on-site meeting to discuss the above were previously hand-delivered and mailed on November 22, 2021 and November 26, 2021, respectively. To date, the Town and our Consultants have not yet received a response and we wish to discuss these impacts and any preferences for relocations and removals.
